A: Identify Your Neighborhood Radio Watch and Contact Person

1. The first column below identifies the communities within each NRW. For instance, if you live in any of the neighborhoods listed under Oak Hill NRW, your NRW is the Oak Hill Neighborhood Radio Watch.
2. The names in the middle column are "contact persons." For instance, if you live in the Oak Hill area, your contact person is Jeff Jones and Steve Gregorich is his backup.

B: Get a GMRS license

Enter this link in your browser and follow the steps below:

Step 1: Click on “New User Registration”

Step 2: Click on “Register”

Step 3: Click on “An Individual,” then click “Continue”

Step 4: Fill out the form. Remember your password for later. Then click “Submit”

Step 5: Now you can see your FRN number. Write it down and print the page.

Step 6: Click the link in blue above this list of steps that you clicked on before. Click “File Online”

Step 7: Type in your FRN Number and Password and click “Submit”

Step 8: Click on “Apply for a New License”

Step 9: Click on the “v” symbol to see the pull-down menu. Click on the last choice in the list “ZA - General Mobile Radio (GMRS)”

Step 10: Click on “Continue”

Step 11: Click on “No” for all answers. Then click on “Continue”

Step 12: Fill out the page. Then click “Continue”

Step 13: Use pull-down menu to answer questions. Then click “Continue”

Step 14: Check that all information is correct. Click on “Continue to Certify”

Step 15: Fill in your name. Be sure to spell it the same way you did in other parts of the application. Then click “SUBMIT APPLICATION”

Step 16: Print out the Confirmation page. Click on “Continue for Payment Options”

Step 17: Fill in “Payer FRN” and “Password.” Then click on “Log In”

Step 18: Fill in the information. Then click “Continue”

Step 19: Click on “Authorize,” and click “Continue”

Step 20: Print out your receipt. You are done.

You should receive notice of your GMRS license by email in about 2 days.
